

# 2023 Parking and sailing fees, terms and conditions

## Owned/private boats and kayak parking fees:

**Kayak parking fee: £65**

**Boat parking fee: £85**

## Owned boats - sailing fees

**£110** for double hander with two adults as regular crew

**£90** for double hander with mixed adult/junior as regular crew

**£70** for double hander with two juniors as regular crew (need to be Stage 3/Level 2 or above)

**£55** for single hander (adult)

**£35** for single hander (junior)

**£8** per session, for privately owned boats, for which a boat parking fee has not been paid.

## Club boats - sailing fees

**£80** Adult annual sailing fee - (includes one Refresher/Improver coaching session), or

**£8** Adult per session fee

**£20** per session for one day Refresher/Improver coaching session for those not paying annual fee (where one is bundled in) or members paying annual fee who require more than one coaching session.

**£70** Junior annual sailing fee (includes RYA Onboard sessions) or

**£7** Junior per session fee (Note: post-Onboard training will be subject to additional training fees)

**Note: All fees in bold should be store products capable of being ordered with the associated terms and conditions. All fees to be paid via club website store, not by BACS transfer**

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### Boat and kayak parking terms and conditions

- 1) You will not be permitted to park your boat or kayak, or to enter club sailing events until the relevant fee has been paid.
- 2) Owner sailing fees are not transferable to club boats (and vice versa)
- 3) Owned boats must pay both parking and relevant sailing fee (not just parking).
- 4) As parking spaces are limited, if your boat is not used on a regular basis you may be asked to remove it without refund.
- 5) Boats are to be left on launching trolleys only (not on road trailers) whilst being kept in the compounds.
- 6) All boat or kayak annual parking/sailing fees must be paid before 1st March 2023
- 7) Proof of insurance must be offered, including at least £2m public/third party liability

## **Sailing fee - general terms and conditions**

- 1) Sailors should follow our Operation Procedures, Guidance & Safety Management Plan for Club Racing, Training & Social Sailing which is posted on the club notice boards and also available on the club website.
- 2) Whilst sailing under the club burgee, members must conform with instructions from the Race Officer/Session Leader and safety boat personnel.
- 3) Suitable clothing and adequate personal buoyancy aids are to be worn AT ALL times on the water.
- 4) Designated experienced helms/instructors do not pay per session sailing fee when taking out novice juniors or novice adults during club or formal taster sessions - subject to VC approval.
- 5) Juniors with a Stage 2 certificate can helm a club boat in club sessions, subject to agreement of Race Officer/Session Lead.
- 6) Instructors who own double hander boats and deliver at least 6 RYA adult training course days or more per year, pay parking and single hander equivalent sailing fee (£55) and can use club boats free of charge. Instructors with single hander boats, and deliver at least 6 RYA adult training course days or more per year, pay relevant parking and sailing fees and can use club boats free of charge
- 7) If you have any medical conditions that may affect you whilst sailing or will affect how we should respond to you in the event of an accident please request a medical form.
- 8) All juniors club boat annual sailing fees must be paid before end April 2023
- 9) All adult club boat annual sailing fees must be paid before end March 2023

## **Sailing fee - club racing terms and conditions**

Please accept my entry for the BCSC Club Racing Programme, associated Special Races and Social Sailing Sessions. I declare that:

- 1) I agree to be bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 and all other Rules that govern the scheduled races.
- 2) I have read and understood the Sailing Instructions for BCSC Club Racing 2023. In particular, I have noted paragraphs 9 (Scoring), 11 (Personal Buoyancy and Safety), 14 (Disclaimer of Liability) and 15 (Insurance) of the Sailing Instructions and confirm that I agree to their provisions and that my boat will conform to their requirements throughout the programme.
- 3) I understand and accept Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing which states it is my decision alone to participate in a race.
- 4) I will familiarise myself with the Sailing Instructions, club procedures and risk assessment information.
- 5) I have either submitted a medical form or I do not have any medical conditions that may affect me whilst sailing or will affect how the club should respond in the event of an accident.

## **Juniors sailing fee Parental Declaration**

Parents and guardians are advised that the club is only able to provide rescue facilities during the hours of club racing. Outside these hours, parents and guardians have sole responsibility for their children and wards and must appreciate that the club cannot be expected to exercise supervision or control. Even during club racing the club cannot accept responsibility for children, or any other persons, not engaged in racing.

## **Additional Parent/Guardian declaration**

Under law, this helm and or crew is my dependant, and I accept paragraph 14 of the Notice of Race which excludes my dependant's right to claim compensation in certain circumstances. I declare that during the programme the boat will have valid and current third party insurance as set out in paragraph 15 of the Notice of Race. I confirm that my dependant is competent to take part and that I am responsible for my dependant throughout the programme.

During the time my dependant is afloat I will be in or around Babbacombe Corinthian Sailing Club or I will inform the Race Officer or Session Leader in writing who is acting "in loco parentis" during my absence
