# 2024 Parking and sailing fees, terms and conditions

## **Owned/Private Boats and Kayak Parking Fees:**

### Kayak Parking Fee: £75

Rental and occupancy of the kayak and SUP racks at BCSC is subject to the following criteria:

Anyone wishing to rent a rack must be (and remain as) a full member of the BCSC (as appropriate for their age etc.)

If there are no rack spaces available, the full member will be placed on a waiting list.

When a rack space becomes available, it will be offered to the full member at the top of the waiting list.

BCSC cannot guarantee to offer a specific rack space to any individual. It should be noted that some spaces are not suitable for heavy craft, or for anyone with a disability preventing them from lifting. However, BCSC will use their best endeavours to accommodate any special needs.

### Beach Clubhouse Usage Fee: £30

Any member of BCSC, who wishes to use the changing rooms, showers, toilets and/or galley facilities of the Oddicombe Beach Clubhouse, for any purpose, is required to pay a supplementary fee of £30 per annum. This must be paid before the first time that the facilities are used and will be renewable on 1<sup>st</sup> March in the subsequent year. The Beach Clubhouse Usage Fee includes a £10 deposit for provision of an access key (or electronic token), for use solely by that member. This deposit will be refunded, in event that a member ceases to use the facilities or ceases to be a member of BCSC and returns the key (or token) Replacement of lost keys (or tokens) will be charged at a rate of £10, per replacement.

Members are advised that, if they do not wish to use the clubhouse, but still intend to use a dinghy, kayak, canoe or SUP, that is stored in the boat park, they may do so, but will need to make their own arrangements for changing, and use of alternative toilets (At time of writing, public access toilets are provided on the promenade, at a cost of £0.30 per entry – payable by automatic debit/credit card terminal)

## **Boat Parking and Sailing Fees for Privately Owned Boats**

(Please see Terms and Conditions, below)

£205 for double hander with two adults as regular crew

£185 for double hander with mixed adult/junior as regular crew

£165 for double hander with two juniors as regular crew (need to be Stage 3/Level 2 or above)

£150 for single hander (adult)

£130 for single hander (junior)

£12 per session, for privately owned boats, for which a boat parking fee has not been paid.

## Club boats - sailing fees

£180 Adult annual sailing fee - (includes one Refresher/Improver coaching session),

or

£12 Adult per session fee

(Please note that, if sailing more than 15 sessions in season, it may be cheaper to purchase an annual sailing fee, as above)

£20 per session for one day Refresher/Improver coaching session for those not paying annual fee (where one is bundled in) or members paying annual fee who require more than one coaching session.

£96 Junior annual sailing fee (for junior members, not participating in RYA Onboard Program)

or

£8 Junior per session fee

(Please note that, if sailing more than 12 sessions in season, it may be cheaper to purchase an annual sailing fee, as above)

£100 Annual fee for junior members, undertaking RYA Onboard Program

#### **Payments**

Where possible, members are requested to use the **MemberMojo** Store Purchase process, available through the **Membership** page of the club website, to pay for any of the above. (**Select Store Purchase** option) Payment by **BACS transfer**, or by **cash** over the bar at the Top Clubhouse, is possible, but members should be aware that this may take several days to process.

#### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

#### Boat and kayak parking terms and conditions

- 1) You will not be permitted to park your boat or kayak until the relevant fee has been paid.
- 2) Owner sailing fees are not transferable to club boats (and vice versa)
- 3) Owned boats must pay both parking and relevant sailing fee (not just parking).
- 4) As parking spaces are limited, if your boat is not used on a regular basis you may be asked to remove it without refund.
- 5) Boats are to be left on launching trolleys only (not on road trailers) whilst being kept in the compounds.
- 6) All boat or kayak annual parking fees must be paid before 1st March 2024
- 7) Public Liability and Third Party Insurance, with cover at least £2m, must be held by the owner and valid for the time that the dinghy, kayak or SUP is parked in the club compound.

#### Sailing fee - general terms and conditions

- 1) Sailors should follow our Operation Procedures, Guidance & Safety Management Plan for Club Racing, Training & Social Sailing which is posted on the club notice boards and also available on the club website.
- 2) Whilst sailing under the club burgee, members must conform with instructions from the Race Officer/Session Leader and safety boat personnel.
- 3) Suitable clothing and adequate personal buoyancy aids are to be worn AT ALL times on the water.
- 4) Designated experienced helms/instructors do not pay *per session* sailing fee when taking out novice juniors or novice adults during club or formal taster sessions subject to VC approval.

- 5) Juniors with a Stage 2 certificate can helm a club boat in club sessions, subject to agreement of Race Officer/Session Lead.
- 6) If you have any medical conditions that may affect you whilst sailing or will affect how we should respond to you in the event of an accident please request a medical form.
- 7) All juniors club boat annual sailing fees must be paid before end March 2024
- 8) All adult club boat annual sailing fees must be paid before end March 2024
- 9) RYA Onboard Program fees must be paid before the start of the Program (normally, May)

#### **Declaration by Member**
